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### Observations of the Committee

This is the second academic audit of Ramanand Arya DAV College (Autonomous). The findings of the committee are given below-

1. Six value-added certificate courses have been introduced during the year.
2. 79 % of the class rooms (23) have been provided with ICT facilities such as LCD Projectors.
3. More than 160 extension activities have been conducted by the college with the help of NSS volunteers and faculty members.
4. New courses and add-on courses such as Data Science in M. Sc IT programme, and Accounting through Software in F Y B. Com programme have been introduced.
5. Eight courses have been made available to the students through the SWAYAM portal.
6. Uploading of the documents relating to the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) for all the first-year students of all the undergraduate and postgraduate programmes on the NAD portal, has been successfully completed.
7. Seven skill development courses on Grooming and Personality Development, Effective Communication and Presentation Skills, Cyber Security, Digital Marketing, Events and Experiential Marketing, Sports Management and Web Development have been introduced by the college during the year.
8. Courses related to Indian Knowledge System have also been introduced.
9. Technology-driven real-time communication has been used for improving the speed of communication between the administration/faculty and students.
10. Transparency is seen in all financial matters.
11. Results are declared within 15 days after the last date of examination.
12. Student: Teacher ratio is very high.
13. Mentoring system is in practice.
14. The teaching and non-teaching posts are filled as per the Act and Statutes of the government and university.
15. The college has excellent facilities for carrying out all curricular and co-curricular activities.
16. There are water purifiers on every floor, the washrooms are well-maintained, and a sanitary napkin vending machine is installed in the girls' common room.
17. There is sufficient parking space for vehicles.
18. The security system covers the entire campus and high-resolution cameras have been installed in the entire campus.
19. The gymnasium has the latest equipment and is very well maintained.
20. The college has two solar panels, each generating 10 Kw power. The diesel power generator is functional, and it generates 10 Kw power.
21. The college auditorium is well maintained with a very effective air conditioning system.
22. The minutes of the meetings of all the bodies and committees are properly maintained.
23. The academic activities carried out in the college are regularly reviewed by the IQAC.
24. The stakeholders are consulted for conducting the academic and co-curricular activities of the college.





### Future Plans


1. Introduction of more short-term certificate courses and skill development courses.
2. Strengthening collaboration with outside organizations for the benefit of faculty and students.
3. Enhancing IT infrastructure.
4. Introduction of new self-finance courses as per the demand of students, society and employers.

### Suggestions & Recommendations

1. Number of teachers having Ph.D. should be increased.
2. The number of research papers published by faculty should be increased.
3. More collaborations with external organizations should be increased for providing internships and project work to students as well as for delivering lectures.
4. Teachers should be encouraged to generate funds through research proposals submitted to various funding agencies.
5. Students should be encouraged to participate in placement activities and more organizations should be invited for placement drives.
6. Teachers should be encouraged to participate in large number of seminars, workshops and conferences.
7. The percentage of student's placement and progression needs to be improved.
8. Teaching plans should be prepared and properly monitored.
9. Provision should be made to felicitate students and teachers for their achievements in teaching, research, sports and cultural activities.
10. Desired number of teachers should be appointed to bring the student: Teacher ratio to about 40:1.
