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## Overview

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The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of Ramanand Arya D.A.V. College (Autonomous) actively conducted a wide range of regular activities throughout the academic year 2025–2026, with the objective of developing social responsibility, leadership qualities, environmental consciousness, and community service among volunteers.

The NSS unit enrolled 200 volunteers who enthusiastically participated in various programmes and outreach initiatives organized at the college, area, district, and university levels. Over the course of the year, volunteers devoted approximately 198 hours of service through regular activities — collective effort that reflects the true spirit of the NSS motto, “Not Me But You.”

## Environmental Conservation & Cleanliness

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The academic year commenced with environmental conservation activities aimed at building lasting sustainability habits among volunteers:

- Inauguration and ongoing maintenance of a compost pit
- E-waste collection drives
- Tree plantation programmes
- Bird feeder making and water stations for birds

Volunteers also took part in a series of cleanliness campaigns, including:

- Beach cleaning drives
- Forest cleaning at Your Hills
- Station cleaning
- Library cleaning and NSS room maintenance

These activities helped promote environmental sustainability and instilled a sense of civic responsibility among students.

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## **National & Social Observances**

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The NSS unit celebrated a number of important national and social occasions, including Ambedkar Jayanti, Maharashtra Day, August Kranti Din, Constitution Day, Kargil Vijay Diwas, Swami Vivekananda Jayanti, Marathi Bhasha Divas, and International Women's Day. Through rallies, pledge-taking ceremonies, seminars, and awareness programmes, volunteers gained a deeper understanding of the nation's heritage, constitutional values, and social responsibilities.

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## **Health & Wellness**

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Health and wellness remained a major focus throughout the year. Volunteers participated in:

- International Yoga Day celebrations and yoga camps
- Mental health awareness programmes
- Health check-up camps
- Blood donation camps and stem cell registration drives
- Seminars on tuberculosis, HIV/AIDS, women's hygiene, and cancer awareness

These initiatives contributed significantly to spreading awareness about physical and mental well-being among students and the wider community.

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## **Social Awareness Campaigns**

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Several awareness programmes were organized on important social issues, including cyber security, cybercrime prevention, child protection, drug abuse prevention, social justice, plastic pollution, sexual harassment prevention, and women empowerment. Poster-making competitions, essay-writing competitions, quiz contests, rallies, seminars, and workshops provided volunteers with opportunities to educate society and strengthen their own understanding of these issues.

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## **Collaboration & Leadership**

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The NSS unit actively collaborated with a number of organisations, including Mumbai University, Akshara Foundation, MDACS, Rotary Club, Nair Hospital, ICC, ABVP, Bisleri – Bottles for Change, Green Club, and various other social organisations.

Volunteers also participated in leadership camps, marathon events, crowd management during Ganesh Visarjan, polio immunisation drives, Red Ribbon Club activities, and community outreach programmes — enhancing their leadership, communication, and organisational skills.

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## **Community Service**

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Special emphasis was given to community service through activities such as blood donation awareness campaigns, donation drives, support programmes for children, social awareness rallies, and public service initiatives.

Volunteers also paid tribute to the victims of the Pahalgam terrorist attack and participated in programmes promoting national unity and social harmony.
